## 3D Map Generator

Create your own 3D maps with only one click! Every shape is possible and delivers a professional result. Ideal for web graphics, infographics or presentations.

Choose between three different directions (left, right or frontal). The tileable texture can be moved unlimited and the shadows and layers of earth are placed on single layers, so that they can be edited every time. Then create your own personal terrain with the 30 detailed bonus elements, which most of them are editable, too. Please also watch the Video Presentation and the screenshot examples. Surely there will be an inspiration for your next project with 3D Map Generator in it.

## 1. Short Instruction

1. Install the actions and styles in Photoshop (installing instruction see below)
2. Create a new shape or use one of the „example\_shapes“ folder and drag it into the “my\_shape” folder. Choose the favored direction (left, right or frontal)
3. Press “play” in the action panel
4. arrange the bonus elements on your generated 3D map

## 2. Advices



The map can be generated of every isolated pixel shape or vector shape.

Only objects inside the document area will be used. Objects placed outside the document area will be cut.

The actions can be used in every document of the size 1200 x 1200 px. The shape has to be placed in the folder named “my\_shape” and has to be visible. This folder has to be placed on the last layer over the background layer.

The tileable texture will be found in the folder “my\_terrain” in the Layer Style > Pattern Overlay of the layer „layer\_1“. A real sharp result will only be achieved with a scaling value of 100%, 50% and 25%.

### 3.) How to Install Actions and Styles in Photoshop

#### Way A)

1. To install the action file, navigate to your Photoshop folder on your hard-drive. This can normally be found within your application folder. Within the Photoshop folder choose Presets and then Photoshop Actions.

Adobe Photoshop > Presets > Actions / Styles

2. Add the .atn / .asl file to this folder.
3. Within Photoshop open the actions panel: Windows > Actions (Option + F9 / Alt F9) and you should see the Action files / Styles appear in the list.
